State Officials Preview Early Actions to Reduce Greenhouse Gases

Members Preview Monday's Public Meeting

SACRAMENTO – Just a year since the California Climate Action Team presented its blueprint for reducing greenhouse gases to 1990 levels, members of the Team will meet Monday to present on their continued progress to meet the Governor's original climate action goals.

Those goals are now law, pursuant to the Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006, also known as Assembly Bill 32 (Nunez/Pavley). To achieve the goals, members of the Climate Action Team are working alongside the California Air Resources Board to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from their respective jurisdictions.
